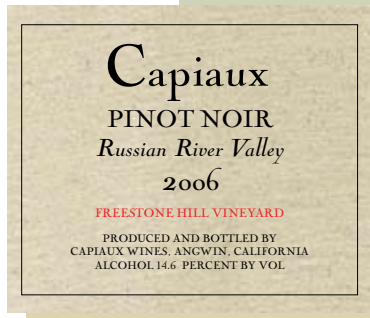

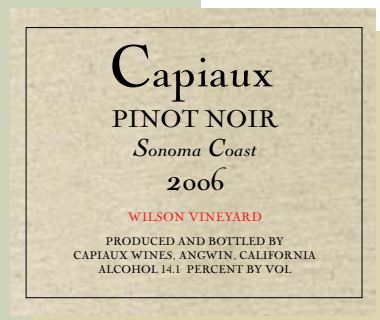

Freestone Hill Vineyard

2006 Freestone Hill has a saturated red purple color with a deep hue. Great aromatics of raspberry, Asian spices and smoked meat. Big, rich, dense and sweet, with a silky, seamless texture and a long finish.

Wilson Vineyard

2006 Wilson has a bright ruby color with a deep core. Currant, Bing cherry, anise, plum, spices and vanillin oak on the nose, with hints of minerality and citrus peel flavor. Good tannin and acid balance with youthful palate feel.

It's that time again to make room for the Fall release of three viticulturally distinct 2006 Pinot Noir vineyards: Freestone Hill, Wilson, and Pisoni. As I sit trying to recall the 2006 growing season, a cool, soggy Spring and intense July heat comes to mind. Fruit ripened evenly and was harvested before the onset of October rain. The resulting wines have versatile structure, smooth tannins and balanced acids...and like a proud, new father, I'm excited to present them to you!

The 2006 Freestone Hill Vineyard is all that I hoped it could be with great concentration, purity and depth that characterize this unique viticultural area. I tasted with Steven Tanzer recently and he rated the wine 93 points.

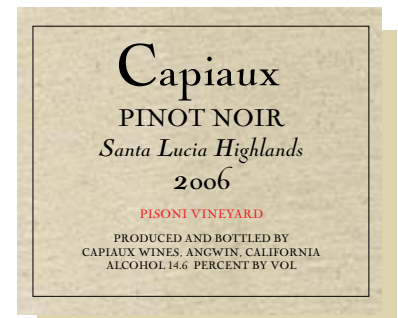
After harvesting less than half a ton of the Wilson Vineyard in 2005 I'm happy to release 2006 with 175 cases of this amazing wine. This is the only wine that I age in barrel an extra 5 months and bottle in February. The vineyard has been farmed organically since its inception and we are in the process of certifying it. (Tanzer 91 points)

We had good yields from our "Camper" section at the Pisoni vineyard and the resulting wine has great balance with tannins meant for aging.

Wish me luck in the Harvest, see you next year.

2006 Pisoni Vineyards has a dark red-ruby color with a purple hue. Big strawberry and raspberry fruit aromas out of the glass. Lavender, jasmine and spices intermixed with forest floor notes. Broad vinous palate with sweet candied flavors of ripe blueberry and wet stones, full texture and rich tannins.
